## **Key Points:**

- A gaming tax credit program is needed to encourage investment into non-gaming amenities. Amenities such as resorts, spas, restaurants and stores are needed to attract players from long-distances.
- Mohegan Sun is opposed to slots being permitted outside of casinos.
- Casinos need flexible or extended liquor hours. Revenues significantly fall after 2AM.
- Mohegan Sun would like the ability to offer complimentary drinks to non-gaming patrons.
- Mohegan Sun supports internet gaming as long as it is limited to current bricks and mortar casinos and players must register for an online account in person at a casino.
- The PGCB's testing lab is unable to meet the increasing demand for new game approval.
